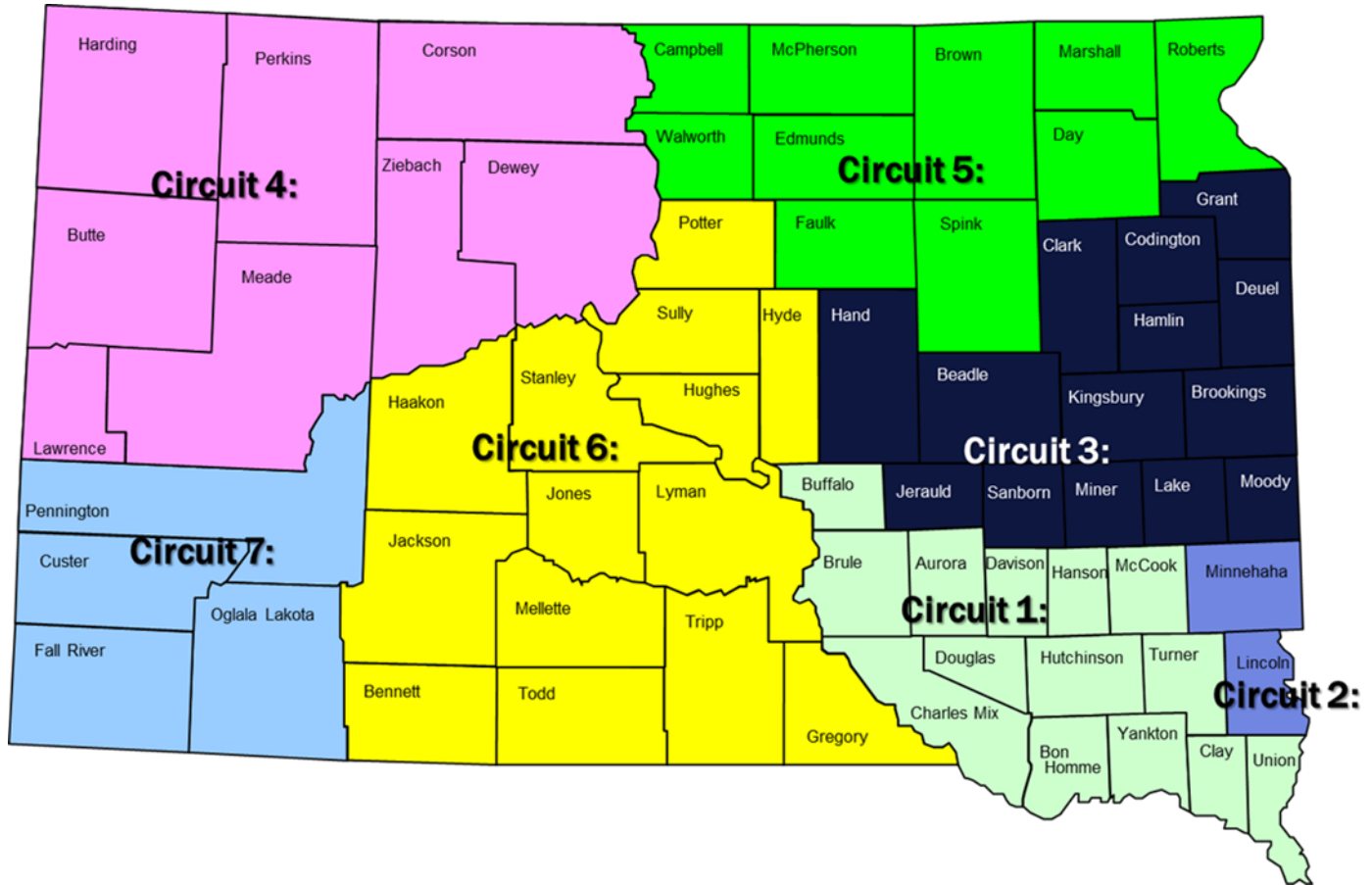

What is the Criminal Justice Initiative?

The Criminal Justice Initiative was established as part of the Public Safety Improvement Act. The Department of Social Services (DSS) provides oversight to accredited agencies delivering evidence-based treatment and intervention programs for parolees and probationers.

How are individuals referred for services?

A Department of Corrections Parole Agent, Unified Judicial System Court Service Officer, or Department of Social Services Resource Coordinator submits a referral to the Division of Behavioral Health. An assessment will be conducted by the CJI community provider to determine the appropriate treatment services based on the client's needs.

Cognitive Behavioral Interventions for Substance Abuse (CBISA)

CBISA is a cognitive behavioral approach to teach participants skills and strategies for avoiding substance use. It emphasizes skill-building activities to assist with cognitive, social, emotional, and coping skills development. Participants identify risky situations and learn skills to deal with those situations as they arise.

Moral Reconciliation Therapy (MRT)

MRT combines education, group and individual activities, and structured exercises to assist participants in addressing negative thought and behavior patterns. The program promotes higher moral reasoning by increasing self-image and promoting a productive identity. MRT includes 12 steps focusing on issues such as honesty, trust, acceptance, healing relationships, and goalsetting.
