INFORMAL, IN-HOME, RELATIVE CHILD CARE PROVIDER CHILD CARE ASSISTANCE SUBSIDY PROGRAM MAXIMUM REIMBURSEMENT RATE

Effective July 1, 2022

Provider definitions:

Informal Care Provider: a family friend or neighbor who provides care only for the children of one family including the provider's own children.

In-Home Provider: provides care in the family's home and cares only for the children of that family.

Relative Provider: must be an aunt/uncle, grandparent or great-grandparent and can reside in the child's home. A sibling of the child may also provide care but must maintain a separate residence.

Reimbursement Rate: \$2.10 per hour for all ages, all counties

If you are interested in receiving a higher reimbursement rate, consider becoming a registered family day care provider. A Child Care Services Licensing Specialist can speak with you about the benefits of becoming a registered provider. Among the benefits of becoming a registered provider include higher maximum reimbursement rates with the Child Care Assistance Subsidy program. Regulated child care providers are also eligible to participate in the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Child and Adult Care Food Program.
