What is *fit*Care?

*fit*Care is an early childhood education and health promotion program consisting of 4 separate classes. All content is developed to aid caregivers in creating a healthy and nurturing environment while supporting a child's whole-health development.

- Sweet Dreams! Exploring Strategies for Sleep and Relaxation
- Mindful Moments! Support Children's Social and Emotional Development
- We Are What We Eat! Creating Healthy Nutrition Environments
- Ready, Set Move! Promoting Physical Activity and Development

Part 1: Complete each class. Upon completion of each class, providers will receive resources to help implement strategies learned.

Part 2: Complete pre-self-assessment and technical assistance.

A pre-self-assessment will be provided for each class to help caregivers create an action plan relevant to items that may need improvement. An Early Childhood Enrichment staff member will work with each caregiver by providing technical assistance consultations and coaching session to help attain success in reaching the identified goals from the pre-self-assessment.

Part 3: Complete identified goals and post-self-assessment. Once the identified goals have been met, caregivers will complete the post-self-assessment resulting in the completion of technical assistance. Upon completion of technical assistant, providers will receive manipulative items for their classroom and be awarded a certificate of completion.

fit is the Children's Health Initiative from Sanford Health, developed to engage and empower children, families, and communities to make healthy lifestyle choices. *fit* provides free online recourses to support that goal.
