The South Dakota Board of Examiners of Psychologists (hereinafter Board), by and through its attorney Timothy Bartlett, Assistant Attorney General, Fred Magnavito, Ph.D., Chairman of said Board; S. Richard Gunn, Ph.D., Complaints Officer; and Keith C. Van Loon, Ph.D. (hereinafter Van Loon), hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

1. That during all times herein, Van Loon has been and now is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board from which he holds a valid South Dakota Psychology License, No. 333, originally issued December 10, 1993, and approved for relicensure on June 15, 1999.

2. That the Board received a complaint on February 8, 2000, reporting instances of sexual contact by Van Loon. The complaint letter dated February 1, 2000, is a self-report of sexual contact by Van Loon.

3. That the parties have agreed to negotiate a stipulation for the revocation of Van Loon's psychology license subsequent to Van Loon's offer to turn in his psychology license.

4. That action of the Board shall be by a majority vote of the Board.

5. That Van Loon shall surrender his South Dakota license certificates to the Board within ten (10) days of service of this Stipulation of Revocation and Order for Revocation. Service is complete upon mailing the aforementioned documents to Van Loon at his last known address.


6. In the event the Board in its discretion does not approve this settlement, this Stipulation is withdrawn and shall be of no evidentiary value and shall not be relied upon nor introduced by either party in a disciplinary action undertaken pursuant to the allegations necessitating this stipulation except that Van Loon agrees that should the Board reject this Stipulation and the case proceeds to hearing, Van Loon will assert no claims that the Board was prejudiced by its review and discussion of this Stipulation or any records relating hereto.

7. That Van Loon understands that pursuant to SDCL 36-26-38 and SDCL ch. 1-27 the status of his license and the contents of the file is a matter of public record, and he hereby waives any right to confidentiality arising from SDCL 1-26-2.

8. That Van Loon understands his right to a hearing before the Board on this matter, and that he voluntarily, knowingly, intelligently, and without further notice, waives these rights for the purpose of this Stipulation and without hearing or other proceedings agrees to the conditions of this Stipulation.






