Opportunities

1. Enroll as an HCBS Waiver Provider
 - Reimbursement for personal care, homemaker, and adult companion services.
 - Services are often already provided by CHRs or Elder programs by tribes.
2. Partner with IHS Health Homes
 - Work with IHS to provide core services to Medicaid Health Home recipients. Many services provided by CHRs, Health Education, and Physical Fitness programs may qualify.



Opportunities

3. Ensure all Available Services are Billed
 - NEMT: Send a request for reimbursement to DSS Title XIX NEMT when advancing funds to Medicaid recipients for medical travel.
 - Enroll Eligible Programs: Tribes are providing covered Medicaid services such as SUD services and community transportation but are some times not enrolled to bill the services.
4. Central Billing Office
 - Centralizing billing will increase capacity for billing for services and reduce duplicative staff.
5. Utilize Electronic Billing Software
