WHY ARE WE HERE?



- o Family Support Medicaid waiver renewal
 - One of two waivers DDD operates to provide services to South Dakotans with intellectual or developmental disabilities (I/DD)
 - Request 5-year renewal
 - o June 1, 2017 – May 31, 2022
 - Renewal requirements
 - o Public Input
 - o Assessing current and future supports and services
 - o Community Conversations
 - o Survey
 - o Tribal Nation notification
 - o Public comment period – 30 days

 - Vehicle modification
 - Specialized Medical Adaptive Equipment and Supplies
 - Nutritional supplements
 - **Family Support does not provide funding for room and board or residential services**

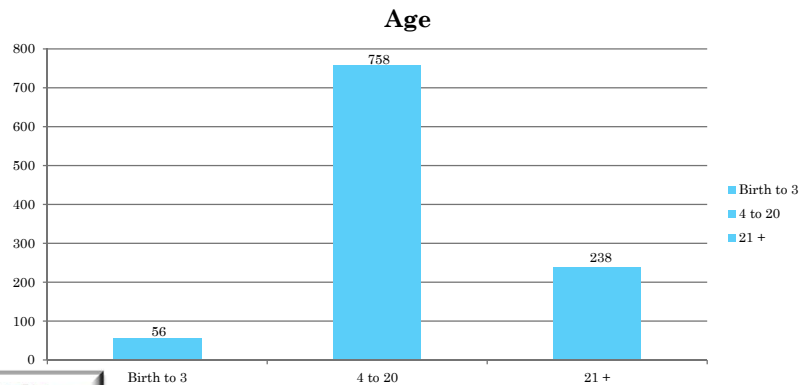

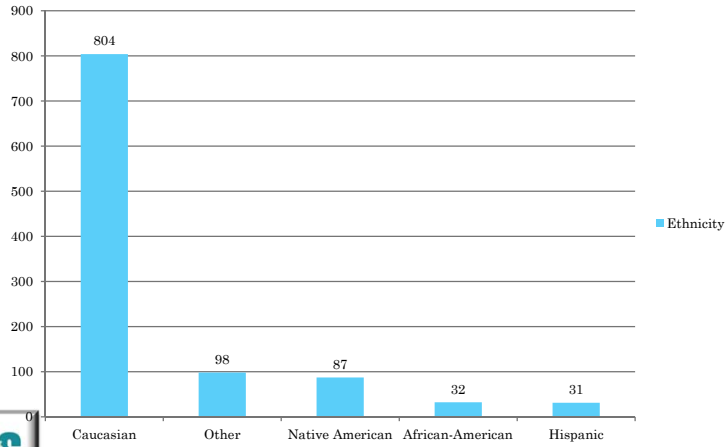

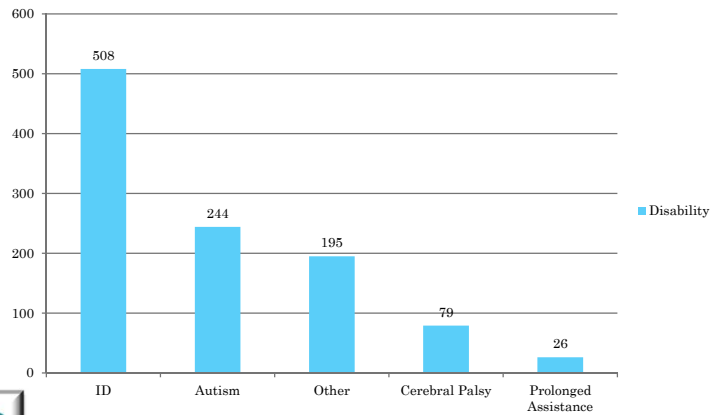
Ethnicity



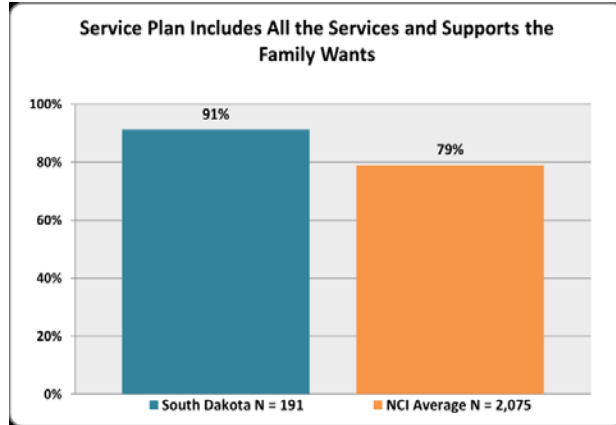

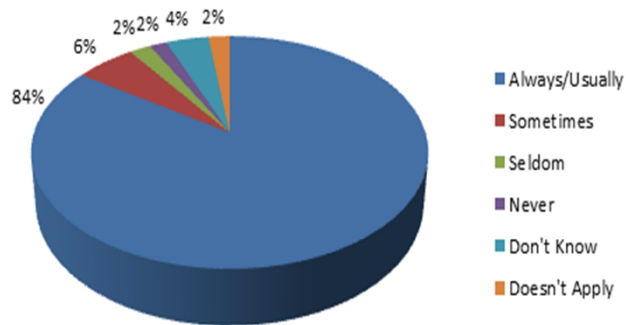

WHAT CHANGES ARE BEING PROPOSED?



- Current waiver vs draft waiver
 - Creation of new performance measures
 - Appendix G
 - Appendix I
 - Refinement of performance measures
 - Appendices A, B, D, G and I
 - Revision of unduplicated participant count
 - Revision of projected waiver expenditures
 - Waiver language updated to reflect intellectual or developmental disability per House Bill 1012

WHAT CHANGES ARE BEING PROPOSED?



- New sub-assurances
 - Appendix G – Participant Safeguards
 - New sub-assurance related to an incident management system
 - New sub-assurance related to the use or prohibition of restrictive interventions
 - New sub-assurance related to health care standards
 - Appendix I – Financial Accountability
 - New sub-assurance related to rates and approved methodology in the waiver cycle
- Refined performance measures
 - Appendices A, B, D, G and I
 - Approved 2015 Evidence Report
 - CMS recommendations to refine performance measures in approved waiver

SECURING PUBLIC INPUT



- Compilation of survey data
- Presenting waiver renewal to South Dakota's Nine Tribal Nations
 - Formal letter
 - Presentation to the Tribal Relations Committee
- Presenting waiver renewal to Medicaid Advisory Committee
- Posting of Medicaid waiver renewal – 30 days
- Submission of Medicaid waiver renewal to CMS by March 1, 2017
- Approval of waiver application by CMS for implementation effective June 1, 2017
