PROCESS TO ACCESS PRESCRIPTION ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

Prescription assistance is offered in the way of Prescription Assistance Programs (PAPs), which are created by pharmaceutical companies to provide free or discounted medication to people who are unable to afford them.

Each program has its own qualifying criteria and eligibility so application requirements vary by drug company.

An applicant typically has to apply to each program separately. If you have access to a computer at home or through a public library, log on to www.needymeds.org and click on Patient Savings and then Prescription Assistance or www.pparx.org and click on Prescription Assistance Programs and then Patient Assistance Programs.
