





Long Term Scorecard: Affordability and Access Rank: 2014



Long Term Scorecard: Choice of Setting and Provider Rank: 2014












Median annual nursing home private pay rate as a percentage of median household income age 65+


Private long term care insurance policies in effect per 1,000 population age 40+




Percent of new Medicaid aged/disabled Long Term Services and Supports users first receiving services in the community





Home Health and personal care aides per 1,000 population age 65+





Assisted living and residential care units per 1,000 population age 65+





Legal and System Supports for family Caregivers





Family caregivers without much worry or stress, well rested





Region 8 - Colorado

- 11 active waiver programs
- 4 serve elderly adults and/or adults with disabilities
 - CO Persons with Brain Injury
 - CO Elderly, Blind and Disabled
 - CO Persons with Spinal Cord Injury
 - CO HCBS Waiver for Community Mental Health Supports



Region 8 - Montana

- 6 active waiver programs
- 1 serves elderly adults, adults with disabilities
 - MT Big Sky
 - MT HCB Waiver for Adult with Severe Disabling Mental Illness



Region 8 - North Dakota

- 6 active waiver programs
- 3 serve adults
 - ND Medicaid Waiver HCBS
 - Children's Hospice (includes adults)
 - ND Technology Dependent Medicaid Waiver



Region 8 - South Dakota

- Four active waiver programs
- 2 service elderly adults or adults with physical disabilities
 - SD HCBS Waiver for South Dakotans
 - SD Assistive Daily Living Services
- Additional Waivers in SD:
 - SD CHOICES
 - SD Family Support



Region 8 - Utah

- 7 Active waiver programs
- 5 serve elderly adults, adults with disabilities
 - UT Waiver for Technology Dependent, Medically Fragile Individuals
 - UT Acquired Brain Injury
 - UT New Choices
 - UT Waiver for Individuals age 65 or Older
 - UT Physical Disabilities



Region 8 - Wyoming

- 7 active waiver programs
- 3 adults or adults with disabilities
 - WY Long Term Care
 - WY Assisted Living Facility HCBS
 - WY Acquired Brain Injury



Other States - Iowa

- 7 active waiver programs
- 5 serve elderly adult, adults with physical disabilities
 - IA HCBS Waiver for Persons with Physical Disabilities
