Psychiatric Rehabilitation Program



Program Description

This program provides inpatient services to individuals 18 years of age and older who's mental illness results in severe functional impairment that limits or burdens major life activities such as keeping a job, socially interacting with others, or maintaining personal and household activities. Services are person-centered and recovery-focused, building on the individual's strengths while developing the skills to improve their quality of life and live as independently as possible. Individuals are empowered to optimize their personal, social, educational and vocational skills to live successfully in the community.

Admission Process

There is no direct admission process to the Psychiatric Rehabilitation Program. Individuals receiving these services are those who have been transferred from the Adult Acute Psychiatric or Geriatric Nursing Home Programs.
