## **INTRODUCTION:**

Enclosed please find the list of deficiencies relating to state rules identified as a result of the October 11, 2019 survey your facility by the above surveyor from this office.

The purpose of this visit was to survey the facility and make an evaluation of the operation and to determine its compliance with South Dakota Administrative Rules.

We request that you provide this office with your plan of correction stating the completion date for the corrections, the corrective action you have taken, or the plan of correction that you intend to make. Please use the space following each deficiency for providing the plan and completion date. **The plan must be submitted to our office by October 31, 2019.** Please refer to the enclosed Plan of Correction Guidelines in completing your own plan and retain a copy of the correction plan for your own records.

## New start adult (1310 W. 51st St., Sioux Falls SD) 14 beds downstairs Deficiencies:

1. A clear width of 28 inches was not maintained at the resident's rooms by the corner work stations on the first and second floors. Desks had been placed in the path of egress. Cords for fans and computers dangled down the back side of the desks where the residents would have to walk.

Plan of Correction: Desk has been moved 50 28 inches is maintained and IT is working to get all cords secured and not dangling down. Date of Correction: 10/11/19

2. In the shower in the north corridor on the first floor the fiberglass finish of the small shelf had been broken leaving a sharp edge.

Plan of Correction: The fiberglass noted was repaired and no longer is a safety concern.

Date of Correction: 10/15/19

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3. Throughout the building there were many ceiling tiles with water stains. The building had roof damage in September 2019, and they believed the stains were from water leaking in during the storm. Those tiles should be replaced.

Tiles were replaced that had waterstains from the storms. No other / taking has been noted since, and will continue to be monitered by facilities statt. **Plan of Correction:** Date of Correction:

4. The cabinet below the sink in the kitchen on the second floor was damaged. The particle board bottom was exposed and was no longer cleanable.

**Plan of Correction:** The particle board that was exposed making the surface no longer cleanable has been y repaired with a new cleanable surface, Date of Correction: 10 /18

## New start adult (1401 W. 51<sup>st</sup> St., Sioux Falls SD) 16 beds Deficiencies:

1. The twenty-minute, fire-rated, cross-corridor door by the maintenance office was wedged in the opened position and could not close. The door was equipped with a magnetic hold open device. Removal of the door wedge and testing of the door revealed the door would not close and latch without assistance.

Door has been adjusted and staff has been informed to keep this fire cloor closed, Staff will monitor to make sure the cloor Stays Date of Correction: 10/11/19 Shut and Closes.

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2. The refrigerator in the kitchen was 50 degrees Fahrenheit (F). Testing of products stored in the refrigerator revealed they were also 50 degrees F. It was unknown how long the refrigerator had been above 41 degrees F.

**Plan of Correction:** Any food not meeting the temp requirements were discarded. Refigurator temp was turned down and rechecked. It was cooling properly after turning down the temperature. Staff Date of Correction: 10/11/19 will continue to monitor thi
