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## Behavioral Health Voucher Program | RECOVERY SUPPORT SERVICES

Rates are in alignment with the guidelines provided by the federal funder (SAMHSA) for allowable expenses in direct service programs.

Any of the below services can be invoiced against active vouchers to support the recovery of clients served. Clients receiving treatment cost assistance through the voucher program must attest they are not covered by public or commercial health insurance programs, or attest coverage is unaffordable (co-pays/out of pocket requirements), or services are not sufficiently covered by the individual's health insurance plan.

<i>Allowable cost categories are subject to change based on program utilization and needs identified</i>		
<b>Transportation Cost Assistance</b>	<p>Assistance to the client in need of transportation to and from an activity related to the client's recovery (e.g. going to a session). If the provider purchases the card/service, the provider should maintain receipt documentation for its records. If the client seeks reimbursement from the provider for an expense/service, the provider should still maintain receipt documentation for its records. It is recommended that providers issue one gas card / gift card at a time, and that the client be asked to remit a receipt for its use before additional cards are issued.</p> <p>Maximum benefit per client per voucher: \$200 per month</p> <p>Rate includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Documentation of the services in the individual's record</li> <li>• Tracking services billed by unit and type</li> </ul>	\$25 per unit (e.g. gas cards or Lyft gift cards)
<b>Medication Cost Assistance</b>	<p>Assistance is available to cover costs, as payer of last resort. These funds are accessible through the Department of Social Service's Indigent Medication Program. The indigent medication program provides temporary financial support for psychotropic medication, medication for the treatment of substance use disorders and/or maintenance treatment and/or related lab costs to eligible individuals while other funding options are identified.
