JJRI - FFT Services

- DSS SFY20 Expenditures - \$0.8 million
- Streamlining and consistency with CYF billing practices
- Proposed Model:
 - Would match the CYF modeled Rate
 - Moving to 15 minute unit from session unit
 - Update 1st unit length requirement for FFT services collateral units
 - Initial 15 minute unit contact minimum would be 8 minutes
 - (First unit is 8 minutes to 22 minutes)
 - Referral and Engagement would be rolled into collateral

JJRI - FFT Services Continued...

- Fiscal Impact:
 - Session length
 - Change in billing for Referral and Engagement fee
 - Change in billing for Collateral
 - Number of clients impacted by pandemic
- Proposed to implement in FY2023
- Post rate change monitoring

CJI Services

- A kickoff meeting was held identifying the focus would be to review the following JJRI and CJI services:
 - **CBISA**
 - Convert to a 15 minute unit
 - Follow the outpatient model
 - Implement in SFY 2022
 - **CJI – MRT**
 - Convert to a 15 minute unit
 - Follow the outpatient model
 - Implement in SFY 2022

JJRI Services

- **Adolescent SUD EBP**
 - Follow the recommendations for CBISA
 - Implement in SFY 2022
- **JJRI – MRT, ART, and Proposed FFT:**
 - Utilize the CYF Model
 - Convert to a 15 minute unit
 - Update 1st unit length requirement for collateral units:
 - Initial 15 minute unit contact minimum will be 8 minutes (First unit is 8 minutes to 22 minutes)
 - Referral and Engagement will be rolled into collateral for FFT only
 - Propose implementing in SFY2023
