What is Home Again?

Home Again provides support and resources to help vulnerable South Dakotans live independently.



As a partner of the South Dakota Department of Social Services, we're able to provide one-time or short-term services that aren't typically covered by South Dakota Medicaid.

Our Services

Transition Services

You have the right to live how and where you want to. With the help of our transition coordinators, we can help you secure a housing unit, set up a new housing unit, or make minor modifications to a current unit. Once that's complete, you'll work with your transition coordinator to identify and select a transition team to help assist you in the journey home.



Transportation Services

Home Again services will help recipients with relocation services from their current address back to their community.

Once a recipient is back home, DSS has services to help with day-to-day transportation. To find community transportation you can visit the [Community Transportation Page](#).



Assistive Technology

Home isn't home if you're uncomfortable. With the help of Home Again, we can help someone gain access to available supplies and modifications to better support them in becoming independent in self-care. This may cover items such as daily sensors, medication dispensers, grab bars and more.



Eligibility Requirements

On the Path Back Home

You should have a say in where you live, and Home Again wants to help you get there. Participation in South Dakota's Home Again program is open to any adult, age 18 or older that meets the following criteria:

- ✓ Is a South Dakota resident.
- ✓ Is enrolled in Medicaid or has a pending Medicaid application.
- ✓ Resides in a nursing facility, ICF/ID or other qualifying institution for 60 or more consecutive days.
- ✓ Meets Medicaid level of care and financial eligibility criteria at least one day prior to transition.
- ✓ Will reside in qualified housing upon transition (a home, apartment, or group home with four individuals or less).*
- ✓ Is willing to enroll in and can be supported in the community through the provision of an existing [1915\(c\)HCBS waiver](#).
- ✓ Expresses a desire to live and receive services in a home and community-based setting.

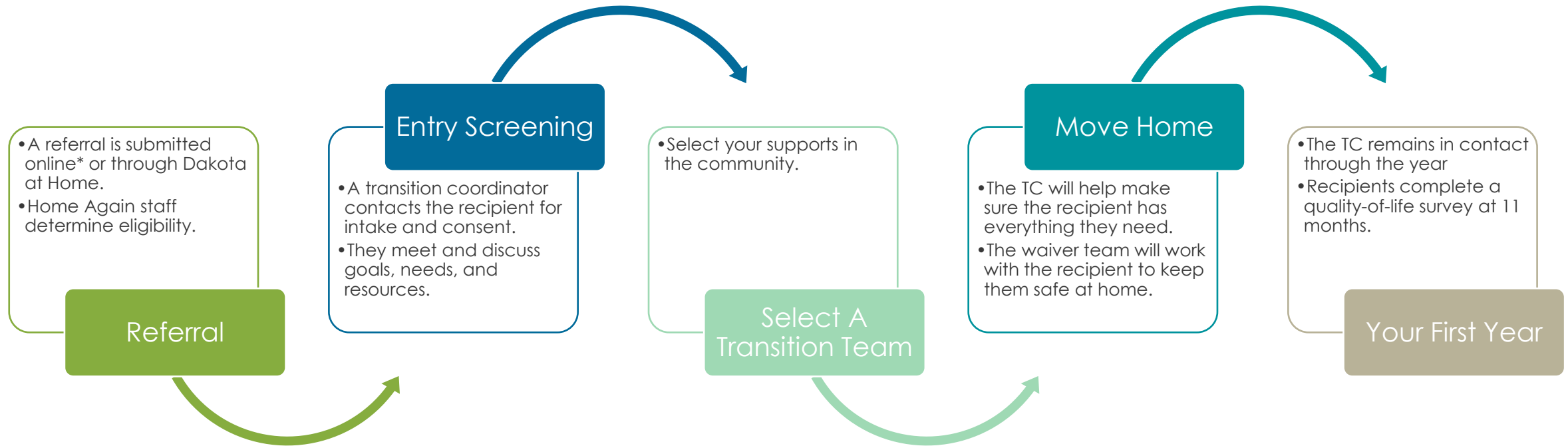

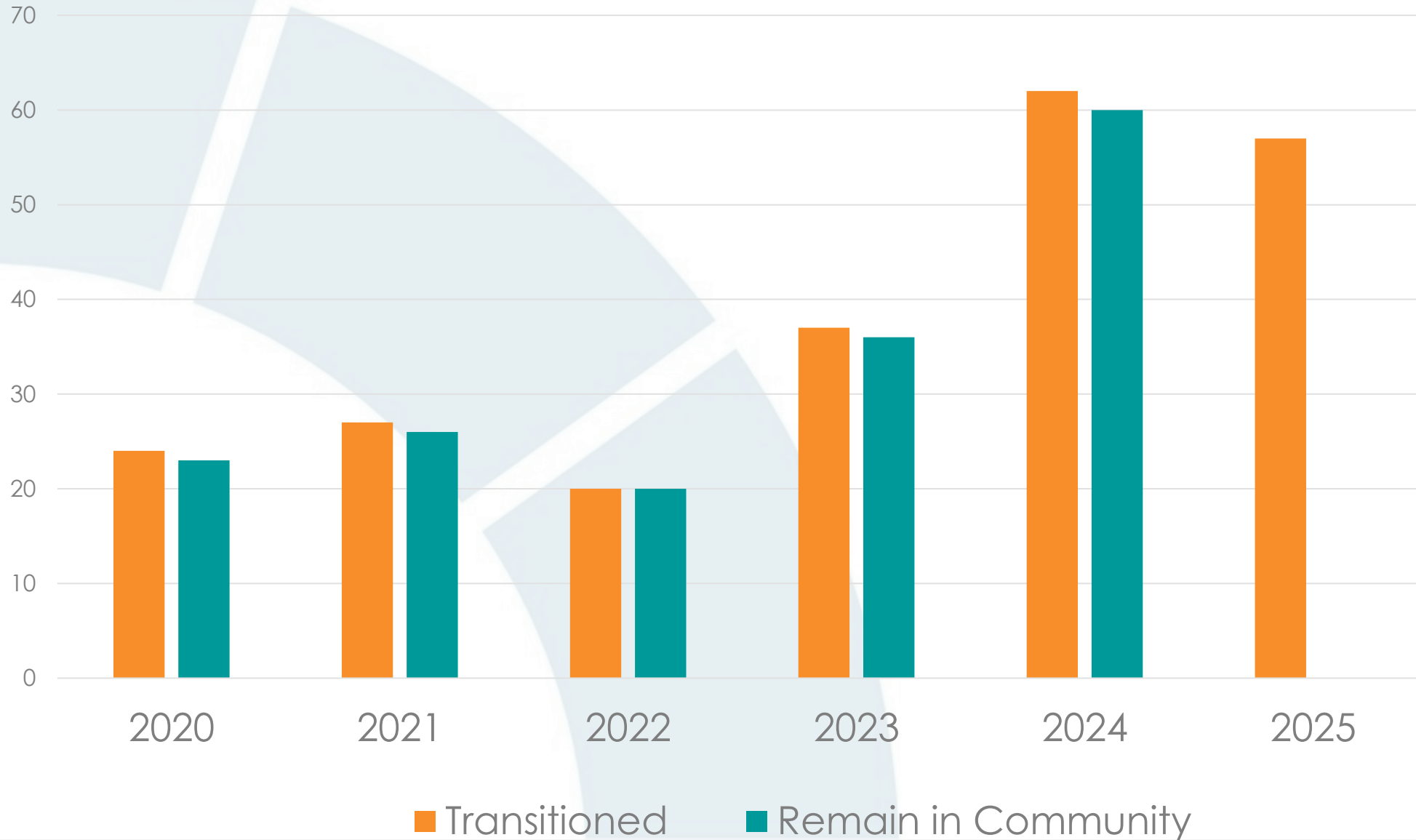

Home Again Process

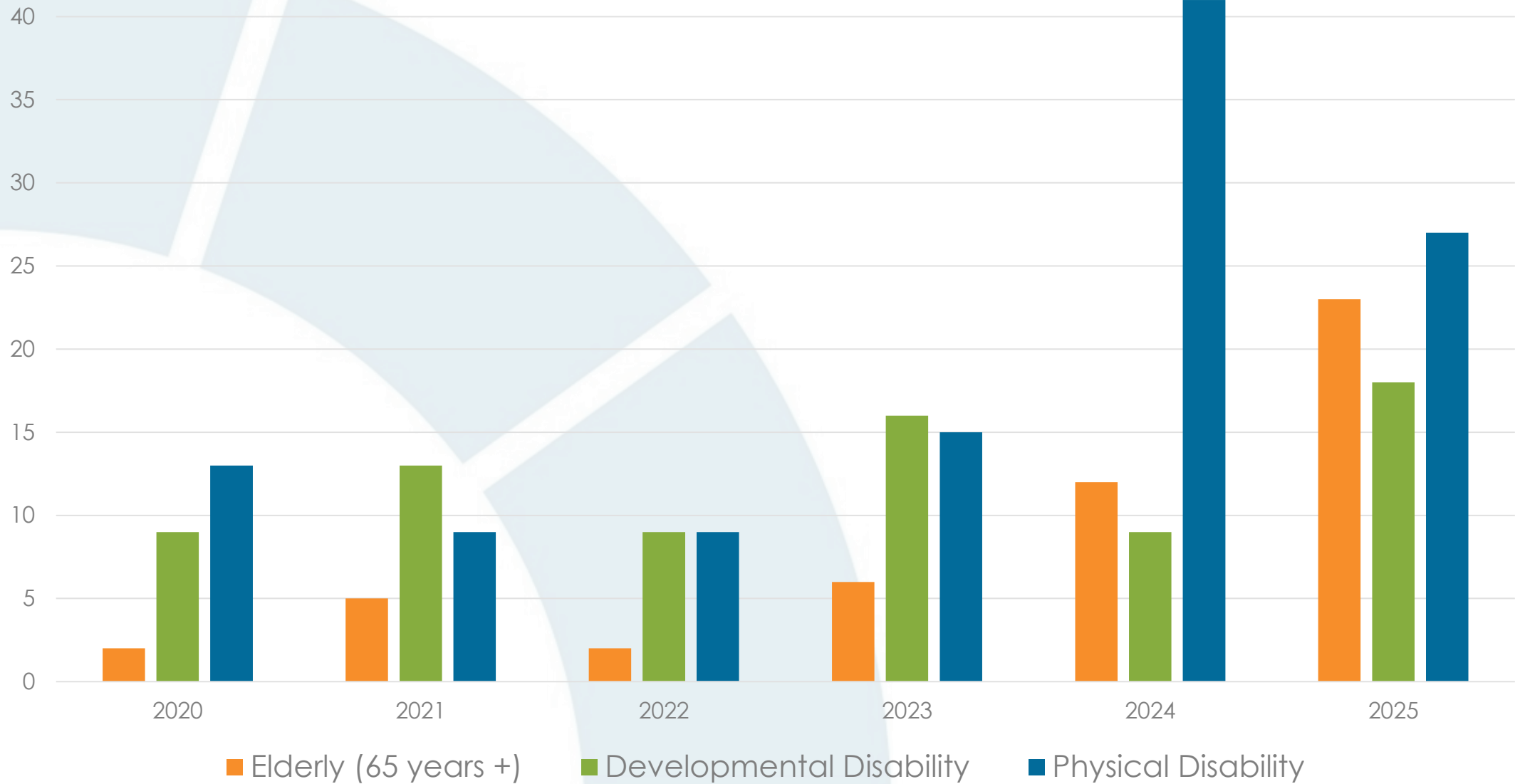

2020-2025* Transitions



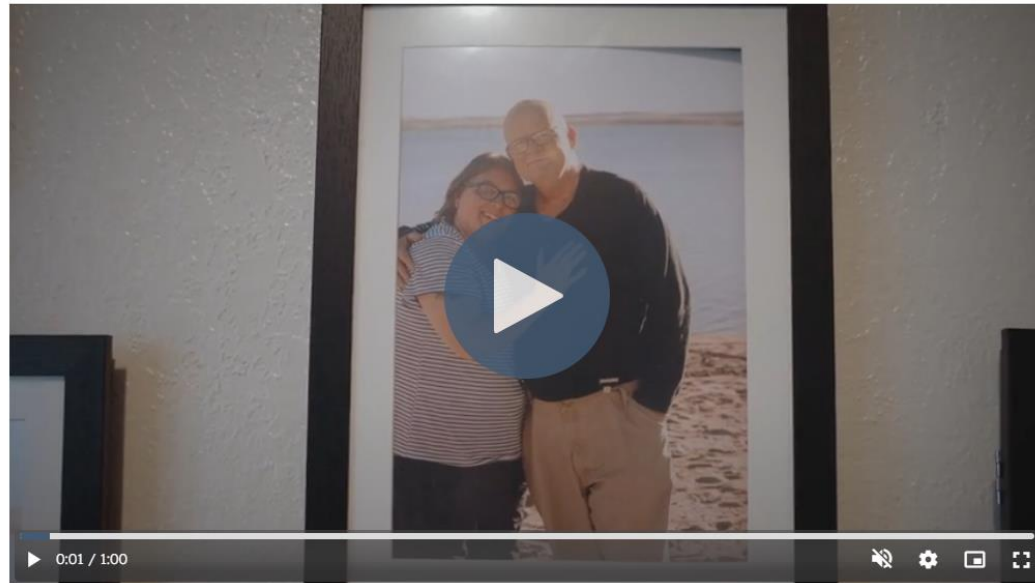
