RE: Immediate Family Members/Members of the Household Providing Care

Thank you for the swift action that Private Duty Nursing agencies took to begin to identify and work with families impacted by the clarification sent earlier this week about immediate family members as paid caregivers.

We appreciate the staffing challenge this may present and recognize the disruption this means to patients and caregivers. We are extending the date by which agencies must make other staffing arrangements by 6 months to allow greater time for us to work in partnership to identify options.

During this extension, DSS will also work with you and families to review and further update the guidance around these services. As described in South Dakota Medicaid's <a href="General Coverage">General Coverage</a>
<a href="Principles">Principles</a>
<a href="Principles">Provider Manual</a>, PDN services are intended to be used for care that a parent otherwise cannot provide (example when parents are working outside the home). This health insurance benefit does not cover custodial care.

Access to care and options to meet complex health needs is difficult in many areas of our state. We understand this issue and are aware that there may be extraordinary case circumstances that warrant additional review. SD will explore the feasibility of a waiver or exceptions process for addressing circumstances where no alternative options can be identified.
