RE: Urgent Care Visit Billing Instructions

Medicaid recipients enrolled in a care management program (Primary Care Provider, Health Home, and Baby Ready) are generally required to receive services from their care management provider or have a referral from their care management provider for services provided by other providers. As a reminder, South Dakota Medicaid will pay for up to four medically necessary urgent care visits per plan year (July 1 through June 30) per recipient without a referral from the recipient's care management provider if the visit is in a non-emergent setting. This exemption is intended to help ensure access to care in urgent situations.

To ensure these visits are exempted from the care management referral requirement, providers should use the following billing instructions:

Claims Submission Type	Urgent Care Claims Instructions
Portal	Select "Urgent" in the drop-down option of item 24c.
Electronic	Enter "Y" in 24c (SV109) and use the situational loop 2300 REF*4N*1.
Paper	Enter "U" or a "2" in Block 10d (if necessary, the "U" or "2" may be added to Block 19 instead of 10d).

Providers are encouraged to submit claims electronically or via the <u>Provider Portal</u>. Providers may also use the portal to check the number of urgent care visits a recipient has had billed to Medicaid using the service limits function. See the <u>Service Limits Guide</u> for instructional details.
