Re: PCP Scorecard

Access and quality of care is a key priority for South Dakota Medicaid. In furtherance of this objective, South Dakota Medicaid will be emailing a Primary Care Provider Scorecard to a designated point of contact with each PCP clinic in September. The scorecard is an informational tool intended to be used by clinics and PCPs to improve the quality of care for Medicaid recipients. The 2025 scorecard evaluates individual clinic performance in calendar year 2024 compared to a specific target for the following measures:

- Preventative Visits (Infant, Child, Adolescent, and Adult)
- Emergency Department Visits (Child and Adult)
- Colorectal Screenings (Ages 51 to 75)
- Breast Cancer Screenings (Women ages 52 to 74)
- Lead Screenings (Children who turn 2 years old during CY 2024)
