

# Primary Care Provider Program



The Primary Care Provider (PCP) program provides recipients with a primary doctor or clinic. Most Medicaid recipients (over 70%) are enrolled in the PCP program.



Providers enrolled in the PCP program are responsible for providing comprehensive primary healthcare services and 24/7 access to information, referrals, and treatment to their caseloads.

The goals of the PCP program are to encourage recipients to establish one source of primary care, increase their access to care, and the quality of their care.



Medicaid will be working with stakeholders in 2026 and 2027 as part of the Primary Accountable Care Transformation (PACT) initiative to evolve Medicaid's approach to primary care.
