

Care Connect Program



Care Connect, formerly known as the Health Home program, provides enhanced coordination services to recipients with chronic conditions.

Providers receive enhanced reimbursement for providing care coordination services.



Support for a Healthier Tomorrow



Providers enrolled in the Care Connect program are responsible for providing or coordinating medical care for their caseload of recipients.

Care coordination services provided to recipients aim to reduce inpatient hospital and emergency room visits, integrate physical and behavioral health services, and enhance transitional care. These services also help reduce Medicaid expenditures.



Care Connect includes quality incentive payments for providers who achieve quality outcomes for measures such as blood pressure in control, BMI in control, and mammograms and colonoscopies up to date.
