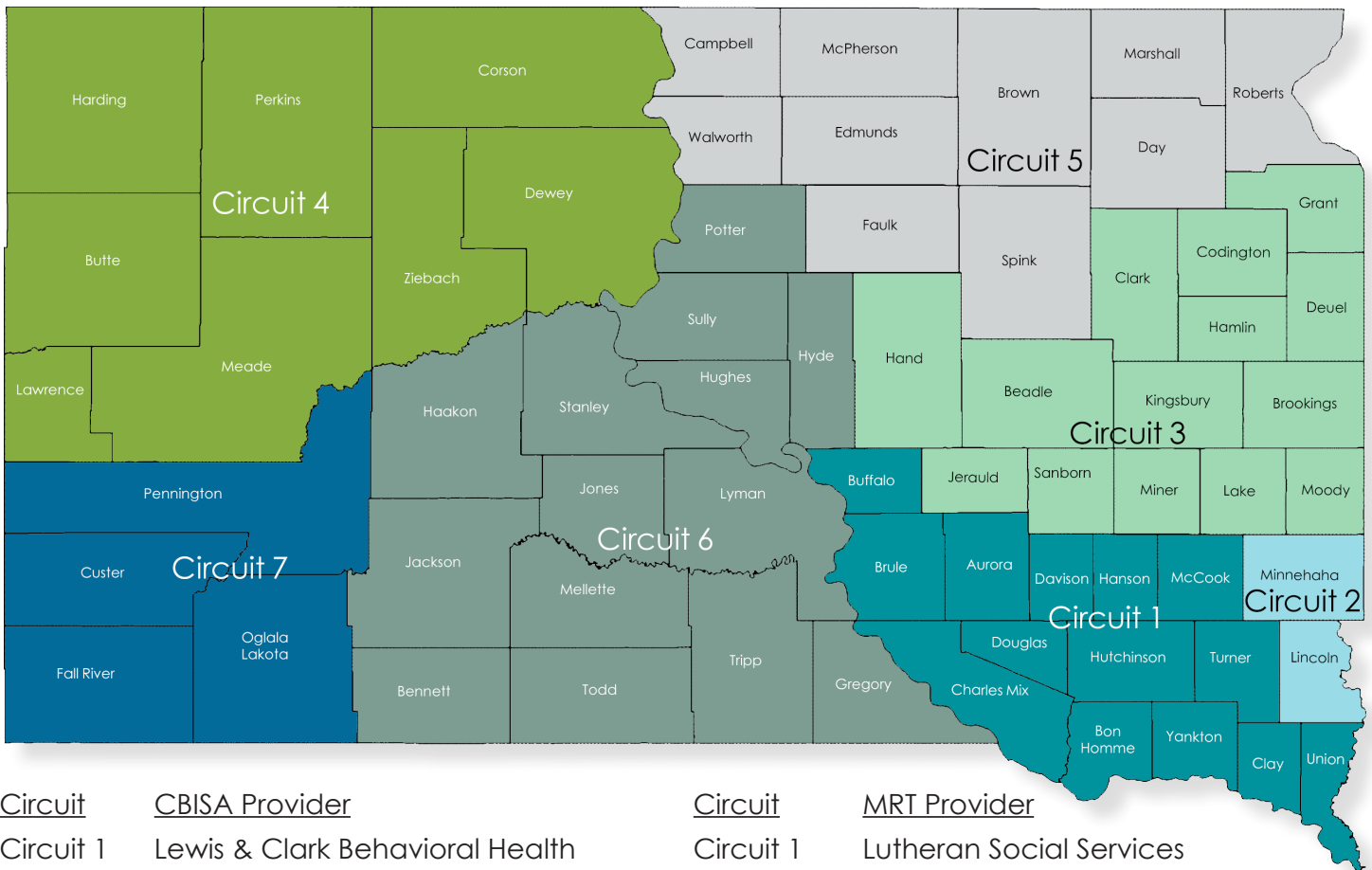


# Targeted Services for Justice Involved Adults Service Coverage Map

## What specialized services are available?

As part of the Public Safety Improvement Act, DSS partnered with Department of Corrections and the Unified Judicial System to identify and implement evidence-based substance use treatment and corrective thinking services for adults with justice system involvement. The target population includes parolees and probations on community supervision. The primary services available are CBISA and MRT.

## How are individuals referred for services?

The justice involved individual's supervising officer submits a referral to a local contracted agency. The agency then conducts an assessment to determine the appropriate services.

## Cognitive Behavioral Interventions for Substance Abuse (CBISA)

CBISA is a cognitive behavioral approach that teaches participants skills and strategies for avoiding substance use. It emphasizes skill-building activities to assist with cognitive, social, emotional and coping skills development. Participants identify risky situations and learn the skills to appropriately deal with those situations. CBISA services are available in person and statewide via telehealth.

## Moral Reconciliation Therapy (MRT)

MRT is an evidence-based program that combines education and structured exercises to assist participants in addressing negative thought and behavior patterns. The program promotes higher moral reasoning by increasing self-awareness and promoting pro-social attitudes and behaviors. MRT includes 12 steps focusing on issues such as honesty, trust, acceptance, healing relationships and setting goals. MRT services are available in person and statewide via telehealth.

Additional evidence-based services may also be available at the treatment agency to meet the needs of justice involved individuals.
