Training will not be pro-rated for providers who are on leave. Employees who only work in programs that operate during the summer months and regular substitute providers must complete 4 annual training hours. 			
	Both Family Daycare Providers and Licensed Childcare Programs Training Requirements				

- > On-going annual training will be accepted only for the training year in which training was completed.
- > The family day care provider or childcare program is responsible for establishing the annual training year.
- > CPR is required before being left alone with children. CPR certification training hours may be counted in the year orientation training is completed. However, CPR renewal hours cannot be counted toward subsequent annual training requirements.
- Training may include on-site or online classes.
- > 1 completed CEU = 10 hours of professional development; 1 completed college credit = 15 hours of professional development.
