**RE: 2013 Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) Psychiatry Crosswalk**

The 2013 Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) Manual includes substantial revisions to codes accepted by South Dakota Medicaid for certain psychiatric services. Effective January 1, 2013, South Dakota Medicaid will adopt the 2013 CPT revisions for certain psychiatric services. For dates of service beginning January 1, South Dakota Medicaid will no longer accept codes that were discontinued in the 2013 update. Providers should bill using the new CPT codes to avoid errors. Please share this information with the appropriate staff to ensure correct billing procedures are followed.

The attached table details a crosswalk between discontinued codes and the replacement CPT codes. Fees for the new codes are posted on the appropriate fee schedules. Fee schedules are available online at SDMEDX:
